A Physical Approach to Playing the Trumpet by Lynn Asper, published by Wave Song Press. An instruction text divided into 20 units dealing with a wide variety of issues for the trumpet player. This method is written in basic terminology and would be easy to apply with students; complete with several photographs and exercises. \$20.00

30 Close Interval Exercises by Allan Colin, published by Charles Colin Music. A series of technical patterns that addresses the development of solid fingers and articulation. Each pattern is written throughout the playable range of the instrument. \$6.95

Solo Time for Strings by Forest Etling, published by Highland/Etling-Alfred. A collection of solo arrangements for violin and piano that are easy to perform with keyboard. These short melodic pieces are well suited for weddings. Violin and piano are published separately. \$8.95 each

Plainchant for Trumpet by Jonathan Gresham, published by Balquhider Music. A collection of twenty-two lyrical etudes based on gregorian chant from the Liber Uralis. \$11.95

Lip Flexibilities by Bai Lin, published by Balquhider Music. A forty page volume of lip slur patterns ranging from easy to very difficult intended for all brass instruments. \$13.95

Daily Studies by Albert Mancini, published by Charles Colin Music. A fifteen parts series including basic routines elements and challenging etudes. \$9.95

“Drudgeries” by Gordon Mathie. Forty-one pages of routines for the advanced trumpet player based on scales on interval patterns. The book includes a reference to other practice materials for scales, arpeggios and chords. \$18.00

Nuts and Bolts of Rhythm by George McNabney, published by McMusic. A method for learning to count, clap and play rhythms. Each rhythmic element is introduced and reinforced through a series of exercises. \$10.00

The Complete Book of Sight Reading for Trumpet by Mark Ponzo, published by Balquhider. A series of rhythmically challenging etudes intended to be done under the supervision of a teacher once each week. Once the etudes are sight read, they should be practiced to reinforce rhythmic understanding and security. \$12.00 each

Trumpet Outings by Charles Reskin, published by Alafia. "Studies and Duets for the Adventurous". A series of twelve etudes and seven duets that are set in contemporary tonalities and style. \$12.00

48 Lyrical Studies by Thomas Stevens, published by Editions BIM. A series of vocal studies based on the vocalises of Concone and Bordogni. Many of the vocalises have been transcribed using contemporary meters. \$18.00

Buzzing Basics for the Advanced Trumpet Player, volume 1 and 2 by James Thompson. A series of jazz, rock and classical "buzz and play" along exercises to develop your tone quality, intonation and embouchure. Complete with demonstrations and accompaniments. \$25.00 each

Jazz Tracks by Allen Vizzutti, published by deHaske. Six jazz/fusion solos with compact disc. The disc has both complete performance with Allen playing the solo line as well as an accompaniment track to play along with for each piece. \$14.95

Vizzutti meets Arban, published by deHaske. Eight "Theme and Variation" works from the Arban Complete Method. The trumpet/cornet book contains clear editions of the solos with a compact disc of Allen playing each of the pieces. The piano book is published separately. 17.95 each

Trumpet Romance, Concerto and Classical Solos, published by deHaske. Three collections with accompaniment compact discs. The Trumpet Romance and Concerto are newly composed works and the Classical Solos are arrangements of standard literature for trumpet. 14.95 each

Hymns for the Master and Praise and Worship, published by Hal Leonard. Each of these volumes contains fifteen hymns and an accompaniment compact disc. \$12.95 each
